"Journalism?" Humbug!

On November 21st, the *IDAHO STATESMAN* ran a *Front Page* article *above-the-fold* in which it gratuitously smeared a retired Boise Police Chief as a "**white supremacist**" merely for addressing a conference sponsored by Jared Taylor's organization, *American Renaissance*.

"*White supremacist*" is a term invented by the *corrupt leftist media* (CLM) to slander those who dare to speak obvious truths about race, a subject the CLM studiously ignores. No white nationalist **or conservative** I know uses that term in a *generalized* sense, because even Ray Charles could see the extent to which black athleticism dominates most professional sports.

On the other hand, the exceptional inventiveness of the white race should be obvious to anyone with an IQ exceeding that of a common houseplant. Whites split the atom, discovered the molecular structure of DNA, landed a man on the Moon, wrote the *Magna Carta* and framed the *Constitution*.

On the other hand, outside of white civilizations, most blacks live as *hunters-and-gatherers*, pretty much as they've lived for tens of thousands of years. They've never invented such basic technologies as the wheel or a written language, and those exist only where they were earlier introduced by whites.

In fact, nearly every important technological advance enjoyed by modern man was invented by a white man, while the vast majority of the inventions attributed to blacks by multicultural race-hustlers were

actually invented by whites. Here again, the CLM has been derelict.
