More Poetic Justice

Just when you thought there might never be good news again -- or anything to make you laugh -- here's an example of poetic justice to bring tears of laughter to your wintered eyes.

For a long time the *DC City Council* has been debating legislation to reduce the penalties for several very serious violent crimes such as carjackings, burglary, robbery, and illegally carrying a firearm. Basically, it would eliminate *mandatory minimum sentences* for felons with guns.
