The People's Republic of Canada

Canadian conservatives have been targeted by the Canadian Government since last winter when the *Freedom Convoys* protested COVID mandates. Ever since, several participants in last February's peaceful protests in Ottawa have seen their bank accounts frozen, their whereabouts scrutinized by federal authorities, their freedom of speech stifled, and some are still rotting in jail. With such a grim depiction of the current situation in the *Great White North*, it's hard to believe that a Canadian dictatorship is not a complete *fait accompli*. Trudeau, who only relies on a minority of Members of Parliament, considers himself to be an *enlightened despot*. Like most woke activists, he feels morally entitled to stomp on democratic institutions and basic human rights to impose his ideology. Even within his own party, people complain of his autocratic rule and how he makes decisions without consulting his colleagues.

Justin Trudeau is the essence of *wokism*, but with a neoliberal twist. His ideological bearings suggest a hasty merger of misguided Marxist Utopianism, combined with an eccentric application of the doctrine of *Laissez Faire*. While the nation is declining economically, Trudeau cites utopian delusions to justify his policies. He misleads Canada with impunity, thanks to his support from a socialist left that has willfully sacrificed the nation's workers on its ideological alter.

Canadians painfully remember the REAL Trudeau, kneeling with BLM, his tearful apology to the gays of past generations and his apologies to the indigenous peoples of the last century. However, few seem to recall that he sacrificed Canadian agriculture on the altar of free trade, or that he incurred record deficits even before the so-called "*pandemic*." Wokism is the distraction he uses to hide the economic disaster he has personally created.

When it comes to the economy, Trudeau's record is catastrophic. It was bad before COVID, and even worse now. The economy was growing every year until he managed to incur \$30 Billion deficits each year, proof if any were needed of his carelessness. His response to COVID consisted of handing out cheques to anyone who preferred not to work -- without any conditions -- probably clouding Canada's finances for the next generation. The government that will eventually replace Trudeau's Regime will see the enormity of the abyss.

But this is not the result of a lack of vision: Trudeau does have a political agenda for Canada. His goal is demographic: he wishes to make Canada a country of 100 million inhabitants. His antics, his pink anti-bullying shirt, and his yoga on the cabinet table should not obscure the fact that he is a fanatic, just as his biological father was. **The** "*Great Replacement*" is coming to Canada, and a few terms of Trudeau will be enough to permanently implement it, especially since there's no limit to the number of people Canada will admit as immigrants.

Canada is currently populated by 37 million people, the majority of whom are still of English or French origin. Trudeau's goal is to increase Canada's population to 100 million by 2100. This is the ambitious goal promoted by former Prime Minister Brian Mulroney -- ostensibly a conservative -- and the *Century Initiative* think tank, which is very closely allied to the Trudeau Regime. Very much against their wishes, Euro-Canadians will become a minority in their own nation they built.

To achieve this goal, Trudeau has opened the floodgates to immigration, something that his nominal father -- an advocate of multiculturalism and sworn enemy of Quebec nationalism -- had always refused to do. Ten years ago, mass immigration represented 250,000 new arrivals per year, a number that has risen to 500,000 and fails to include thousands of illegal immigrants who entered Quebec since 2019. Canada has the highest *per capita* rate of immigrants among the G7 countries because Canadian authorities welcome illegals as "*heroic survivors*."

It goes without saying that opponents of such an agenda are immediately labeled conspiracy theorists or, worse, "*white supremacists*," a term that Trudeau has rendered completely meaningless. His opponents are all *de facto* "*white supremacists*," and those who publicly express their discontent inevitably end up on the *Terrorist Watch List*. This was the case with the *Proud Boys* who, despite never having committed any terrorist acts and -- despite being led by a Puerto Rican -- must have been very surprised to discover their being labeled a "*white supremacist terrorist organization.*" Of course, this designation carries legal consequences for anyone who would publicly defend the group.

This demonization of opponents helped prompt the truckers' protests against vaccine mandates. This movement, which began in January of 2022 was extraordinarily large in a nation where political mobilization is not usually the norm. The arrogance of a Trudeau -- who remained hiding in a secret place while denouncing and vilifying the truckers -- probably helped to galvanize these peaceful protesters.

This did not prevent Trudeau from declaring a *state of emergency* that allowed him to suspend constitutional rights in order to halt the protest. Allegedly, it also authorized the central government to freeze the bank accounts of truckers, seize their vehicles, and arrest them without a warrant. This situation still persists, since many protestors remain languishing in Canadian jails.

If such a situation had occurred in Asia or Russia, the Western media would have feigned outrage, but thanks to a compliant and sycophantic news media, Trudeau was portrayed as the *savior of democracy*.

Fortunately, Trudeau does not have all the levers of power yet! One can only imagine what will happen if Trudeau is re-elected with a majority in Parliament!
