Trump Versus DeSantis

I've always been receptive to the idea that **Donald Trump** deserves the Republican nomination in 2024 because he was relentlessly persecuted throughout his first term by a treasonous conspiracy of criminals and traitors from the Washington "cesspool" Each of them should have been tried for treason and executed. Trump was also cheated out of his second term in 2020 by massive voter fraud orchestrated by the **New Communist Party of the USA** -- wrongly called the "Democrat" Party -- using counterfeit, mass-mailed ballots cast by dead, illegal and fictitious voters.

In his first administration, **Trump** attracted some exceptionally capable and loyal patriots, such as Kash Patel, Rick Grenell, Mike Pompeo, Chad Wolf, and Kayleigh McEnany, all of whom were highly effective and should play prominent roles in his second term.

Unfortunately, **Trump** also appointed some imbeciles and cowards who caused lasting damage, such as *Attorneys General* Jeff Sessions and Bill Barr, *FBI Director* Christopher Wray, *Secretary of State* Rex Tillerson, and *Director of Communications for the Office of Public Liaison*, Omarosa Newman. Trump is often inclined to mistake competence for loyalty to himself.

I may have been the first to describe Florida Governor Ron DeSantis as "*Trump* without the drama," although it could easily have occurred to a number of people independently and for the most obvious of reasons.

DeSantis is every bit as conservative as **Trump**, and would probably be more effective advancing a conservative social agenda. He has worked a number of quiet miracles in Florida by eliminating CRT and woke agendas in Florida State Government and state-funded schools, while removing a slimy Soros-funded county prosecutor, and discouraging **Disney's** promotion of perverts and queers with taxpayer subsidies.

DeSantis is more articulate and focused, and can say in 20 minutes what it takes Trump 2 hours to say with his stream-of-consciousness approach to public speaking. This would make DeSantis -- trained at Yale and Harvard Law School -- a far better debater if Biden's handlers should ever permit that shell of a human being to debate, which is unlikely. DeSantis also has the rare ability to communicate clearly and without flourish, which might enable him to reach many of those in demographic groups whose support the RNC routinely predicts, but which rarely materializes.

Unfortunately, **Trump** instinctively feels the need to savage his competitors, even fellow Republicans. It would be ideal if he'd limit himself to targeting the Jews' Media and the **NCPUSA**, and observe Reagan's 11th Commandment, "**Thou shalt not speak ill of thy fellow Republican.**" This may be **Trump's** least appealing characteristic, and it has made a lot of enemies among conservatives whose support he needs, such as Ted Cruz. His approach to any competitor is reminiscent of that scene from **Godfather II** when **Tom Hagan** (Robert Duvall) asks **Michael Corleone** (Al Pacino,) "**Do you need to wipe everybody out?**" Michael replies, "**I don't feel I have to wipe everybody out, Tom. Just my enemies, that's all.**"

For example, Trump is currently running ads all over *Fox News* and *NewsMax* ridiculing the record of Ron DeSantis while he was in the House. A recent ad mocks DeSantis' support for a 23-cent federal sales tax. As Trump's ads often do, this one fails to mention the intent or context of that bill, which was to replace our federal income tax and make most of the IRS obsolete. Conservatives in the GOP have argued for years that a national sales tax would force every variety of criminal in the "black" (or cash) economy -- such as pimps, prostitutes, drug-dealers, welfare queens and other criminals -- to finally pay their fair share of federal taxes on the cash income they never report.

In an earlier ad, **Trump** also accused **DeSantis** of trying to destroy Social Security with his support of raising the retirement age to 70. Yet, **DeSantis** was merely supporting the kind of courageous reform that few Republicans have the guts to advocate. Before the disastrous consequences of COVID-19 and the side-effects from Fauci's vax, Americans were living longer. Moreover, anyone with a brain could see that Social Security and Medicare were actuarially unsound, a conclusion reached by every expert who has examined the data. **DeSantis** deserves credit for supporting **REAL** fiscal reform rather than see it used to attack him.



In the coming months, **DeSantis** will probably attack **Trump** for signing a couple of trillion-dollar "*Omnibus*" spending bills, that allowed all those Republicans who campaigned back home as "*fiscal conservatives*" to spend like n*ggers with a stolen credit card, and do so in relative anonymity. Each bill squandered a trillion tax dollars snatched from working Americans and capital streams, and every dollar allocated was added to our National Debt. **Trump** deferred to Congressional "*leaders*" like Paul Ryan and Mitch McConnell in supporting those "*Omnibus*" spending bills, despite the fact that the two sought to undermine **Trump** every day of his presidency. *Omnibus* spending bills are how we get such things as that infamous "*bridge to nowhere*." In marked contrast to **DeSantis**, **Trump** is clearly a "*big government*" Republican.

This was also evident when **Trump** deferred to that mad scientist, Anthony Fauci, who rejected the proven public health technique known as "herd immunity," in favor of throwing trillions of dollars at a new and untested approach to immunization. Three of the world's most respected scientists endorsed herd immunity as an appropriate response to COVID in their **Great Barrington Declaration** (GBD,) and the world would be better off if it had listened to them. Essentially, the GBD argued that herd immunity combined with "focused protection" for those with greater health risks ("co-morbidities,") was an approach whose benefits

greatly outweighed shutting down the economy and the public schools, while throwing trillions of dollars at an untested vaccine. The three authors of the GBD have been thoroughly vindicated by recent history for their courageous stance.

Knowing the NCPUSA as I do, I'll bet my house if **Trump** receives the GOP's nomination for president in 2024, he will immediately be indicted by some henchmen of the NCPUSA in order to interfere with his campaign and help perpetuate the Washington *cesspool*.
