Educating Post-Literate America

The *Houston Independent School District* (HISD) is removing its libraries in 28 schools and retiring their librarians. The space that once housed school libraries will be *repurposed* into what the school district terms "*Team Centers*," where violent and disruptive students will be warehoused until school is over. In reality, those *team centers* are actually discipline centers, which will quickly regress into an arena for gang-fights.

This is a reasonable innovation, because the HISD -- like most large, urban school systems dominated by *persons of color* -- is in much greater need of *discipline centers* than libraries.
