Trash Removal

On October 3rd, 2023, the House voted to remove Kevin McCarthy (RINO-Hapless) as Speaker of the House. Soon afterward, the speaker *pro tem*, Patrick McHenry (R-NC) ordered former Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-Gambino) to vacate her large and coveted House office. The office in question is spacious and has a great deal of privacy. An e-mail to Pelosi notified her that the room was being reassigned for *"Speaker Office use."*

Pelosi is used to having her way -- as speaker, she ruled the House like Mussolini ruled Italy -- so she complained bitterly. Some reportage indicates that it was actually Kevin McCarthy who ordered Pelosi's eviction, almost certainly in retaliation for her lies. Pelosi complained that this decision was "a sharp departure from tradition," apparently forgetting that no Speaker has previously been ousted from that position in U.S. history, so there's no "tradition" involved. She also seems to have forgotten that she betrayed McCarthy immediately prior to the vote by reassuring him that her fellow "Democrats" would not vote to remove him.

The most mystifying aspect of this entire fracas is *HOW* in the world McCarthy could believe *ANYTHING* Nancy Pelosi said. That b*tch would lie even if the truth would save her evil soul. This is someone who repeatedly claimed that Trump created the disaster on our southern border. She also conspired to set up Trump supporters on January 6th, 2021 by ignoring President Trump's request for 20,000 National Guardsmen to secure the Capitol prior to the demonstrations planned for that day.
