

Nothing's Free?

When a new Deputy Director was appointed to head Atlanta's *Water Department*, he soon appeared before the City Council without receiving any briefing. Not recognizing that it was a subject **NEVER** to be mentioned in public, he referred to the staggering number of **unpaid water bills** among Atlanta's deadbeat black residents. He then foolishly vowed to make those accounts current.



Atlanta's water bills in arrears amount to \$198,000,000 (one hundred and ninety-eight million dollars) owed on 54,000 accounts. That comes to an average balance of about \$3,700 per account owed by Atlanta's deadbeat blacks.

Beginning in 2010, Atlanta's *Department of Watershed Management* stopped shutting off service on unpaid accounts, according to an audit by the *City Auditor's Office*, released in December of 2023. That audit indicates *Water Department* officials were ordered by an unnamed former mayor to stop shutting off service to those accounts with unpaid balances. That was most likely Kasim Reed, who began serving as Atlanta's Mayor in 2010.

A failure to enforce the collection of delinquent water bills fostered what the audit termed a **"culture" of delinquent accounts**. This situation was aggravated by a *"moratorium"* on service shutoffs that began early in the COVID-19 *scamdemic*. By June of 2023, the city had accumulated \$198 million in delinquencies from more than 36,000 *active* accounts. That's a total exceeding the revenues collected from the city's *special sales tax*, intended to replace its aged water and sewer systems.



This is just one example of the corruption and incompetence of Atlanta's elected and appointed black officials. As mentioned, this new director was never told that those unpaid water bills are never to be collected or even mentioned. Astonishingly, a reporter who covered the City Council Meeting for the **ATLANTA JOURNAL & CONSTIPATION** -- a charter member of the fake news industry -- was also not briefed on the subject, and actually made the *faux pas* of reporting the new deputy director's remarks.

This won't happen again: that will be the LAST mention of Atlanta's scandalous provision of free water to deadbeat nigras that will appear in the news. From now on, the fake news media will redouble its

efforts to show greater discretion in reporting the corruption, embezzlement, graft and outrages that define Atlanta's black-run city government.
