God's Hand



Over and over, for thousands of years When the cries of God's people fell on His Ears; He chose a brave man His Will to embrace And lead His people with the help of His Grace.


One example comes from *Old Testament* Lore Moses was given an impossible chore; To lead God's children from captivity Then, when it was needed, part the Red Sea.
