Is This Feasible?

Once Donald Trump is reelected and staffs his *Justice Department* with honorable people, his Solicitor General might consider granting restitution to the many decent and innocent citizens who were clearly wronged by Attorney General Merrick Garland's weaponizing of Biden's *In-Justice Department*.
